Project: *The UN 2030 Agenda is us! A presentation and discussion on sustainable goals*

Pupils become familiar with the important issues of the future. They also become conscious of what is the role of each and every citizen in the crucial goals we are all called to achieve.

Final product: pupils prepared a presentation about the Sustainable Development Goals which intend to put an end to poverty, fight inequalities and stop climate change. What can we do to make the world a better place to live in ?

The project in steps:

Step 1, warming up activity:

- in your opinion, what are the most serious problems we are facing as a community? As a country? All over the world? In pairs, pupils made a list of 4/6 ideas;
- pupils compare their list with the list of the 17 Goals: how can the problems you have identified be matched with the SDGs?
- in your opinion, who is responsible for achieving the Global Goals? Do young people have a responsibility to achieve them?

Step 2: students formed groups. Each group decided which Global Goal they wanted to learn more about.

Step 3: students selected information and prepared a factfile about their goal.

Step 4: they used the information to prepare a slide presentation about the Global Goal each group chose and uploaded it on the school platform Microsoft Teams so that they could share their project. A class discussion followed.
