PART 1: Pupils read the novel *To Kill a Mocking Bird* by Harper Lee and discussed/debated about setting, plot, characters and themes paying special attention to sociological implications in the novel.

PART 2:

Pupils became familiar with the following topics the teacher introduced:

1. History of African-Americans (including basic information about slavery in America), 2. The Loving Story, 3. Jim Crows Laws, 4. The Scottsboro Boys, 5. Racial segregation in America, 6. The Civil Rights Movement, 7. Black Anger and contemporary Black Anger up to Black Lives Matter.

Pupils organised themselves into groups, each group picked a topic from the above list, did some research and gave a class presentation (a PPT, a slideshow, a padlet, a video, etc.) that was uploaded on the school platform Microsoft Teams.
