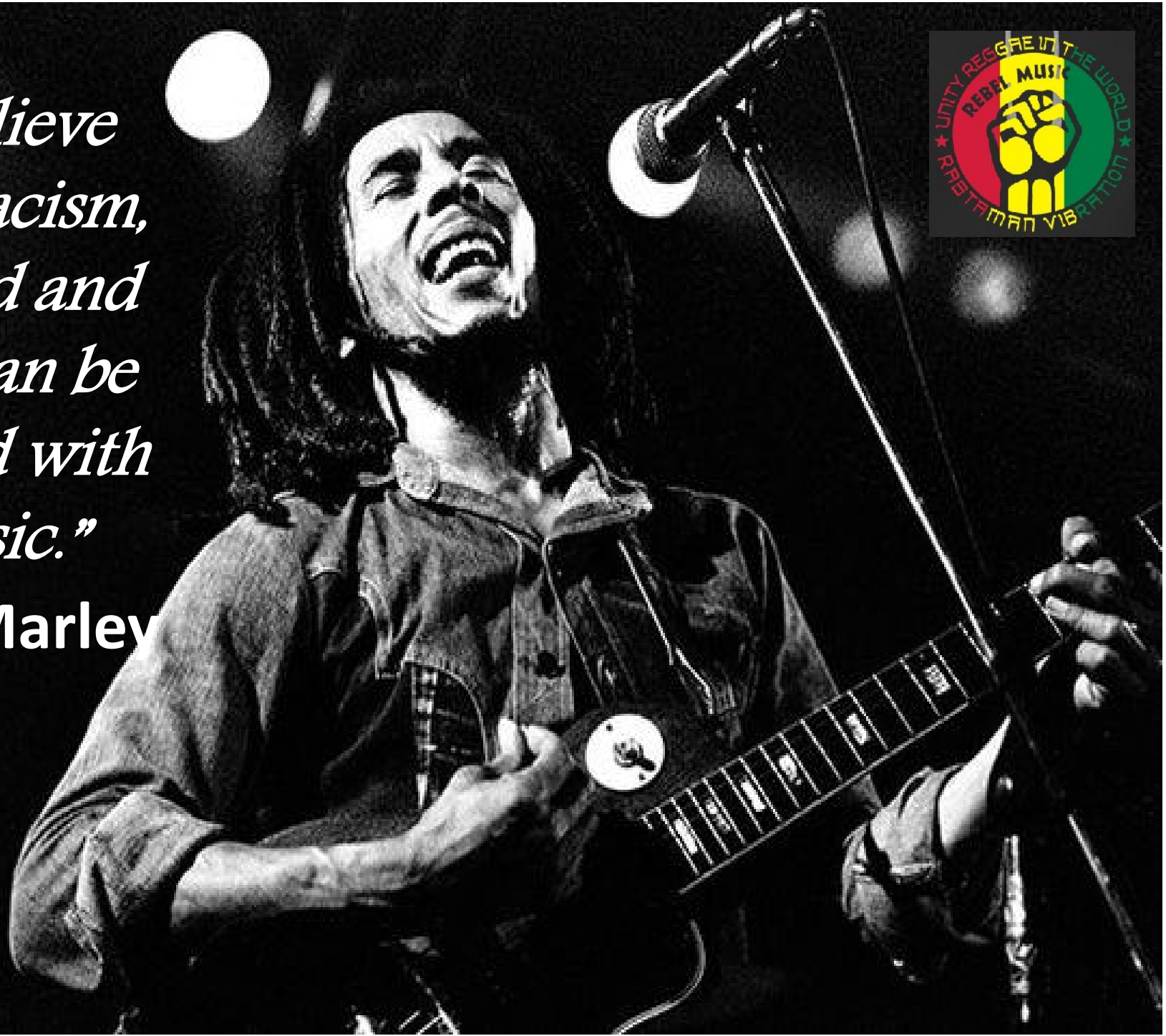

**Nelson Mandela**

- *Nelson Mandela was born in South Africa in 1918 and died in Johannesburg in December on 5 2013.*



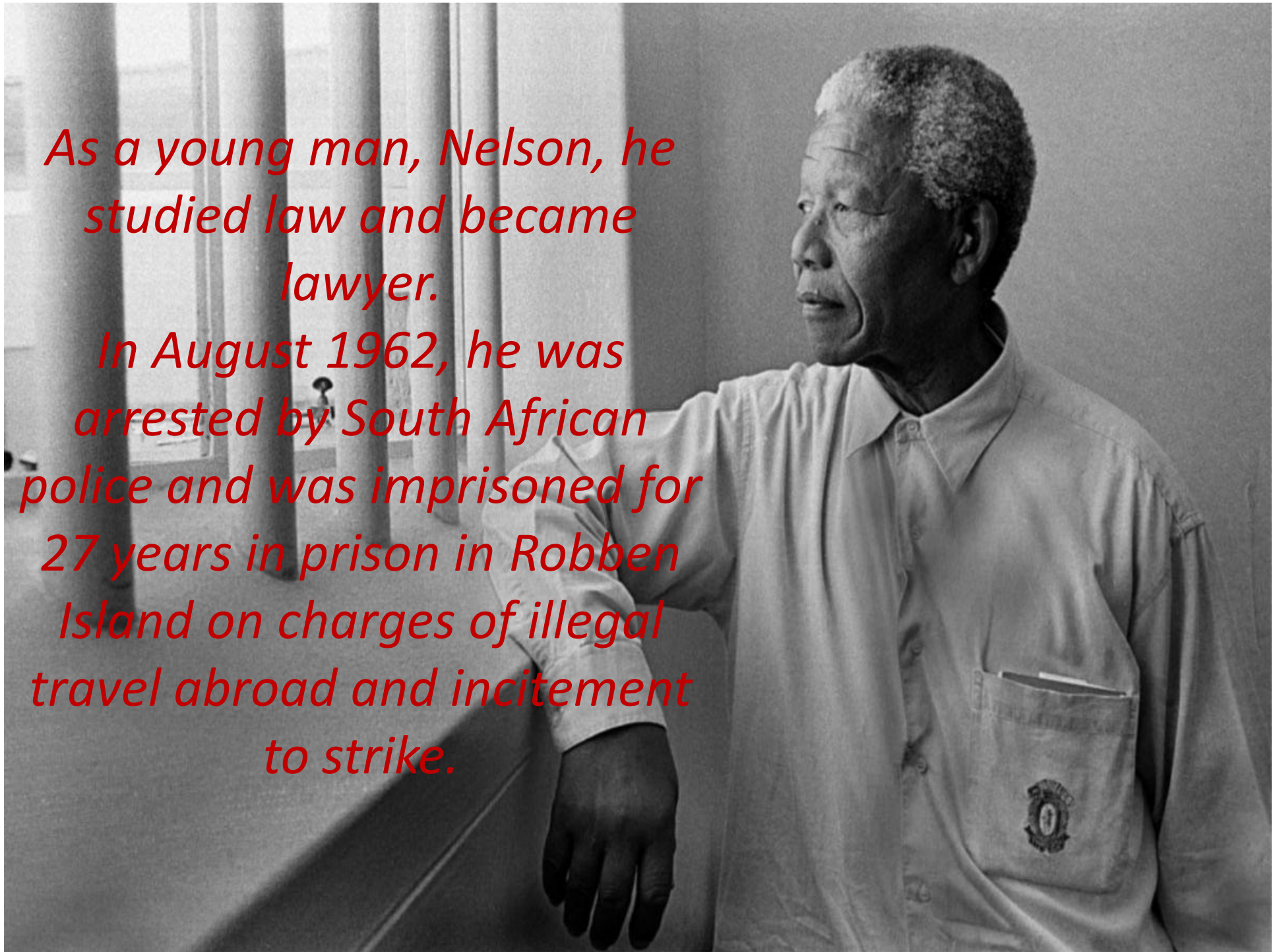

*South Africa had a political system called apartheid. Mandela joined the African national congress. From 1952 to 1960 Mandela was arrested. He was released in 1990. From 1991 he became the president of African national congress.*

*As a young man, Nelson, he studied law and became lawyer.*

*In August 1962, he was arrested by South African police and was imprisoned for 27 years in prison in Robben Island on charges of illegal travel abroad and incitement to strike.*



**He renounced an offer of conditional freedom in exchange for a renunciation of the armed struggle. He was disbanded on February 1, 1990, and the same year he received the Lenin Prize for Peace.  
After three years Mandela received the Nobel Peace Price.**

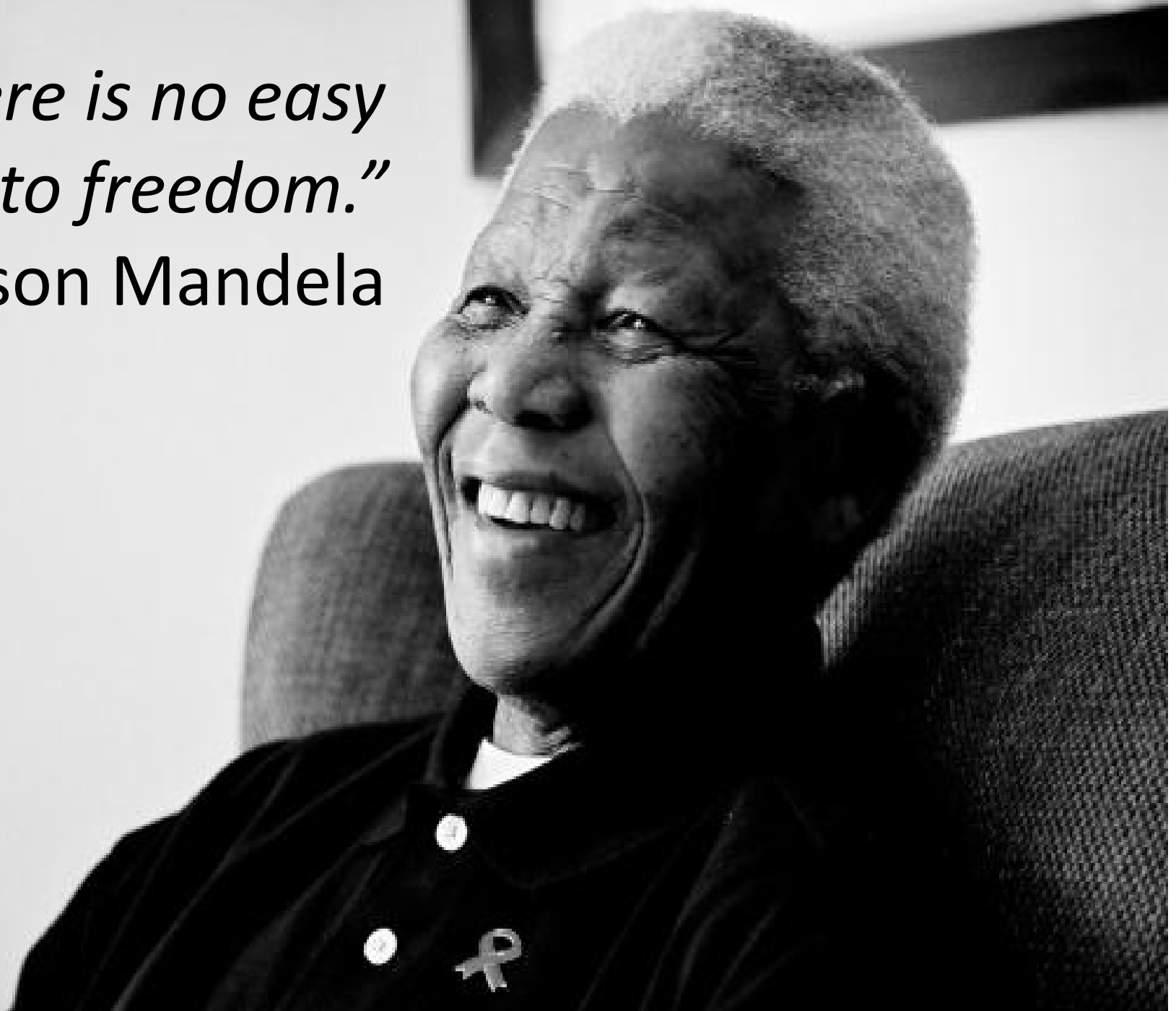

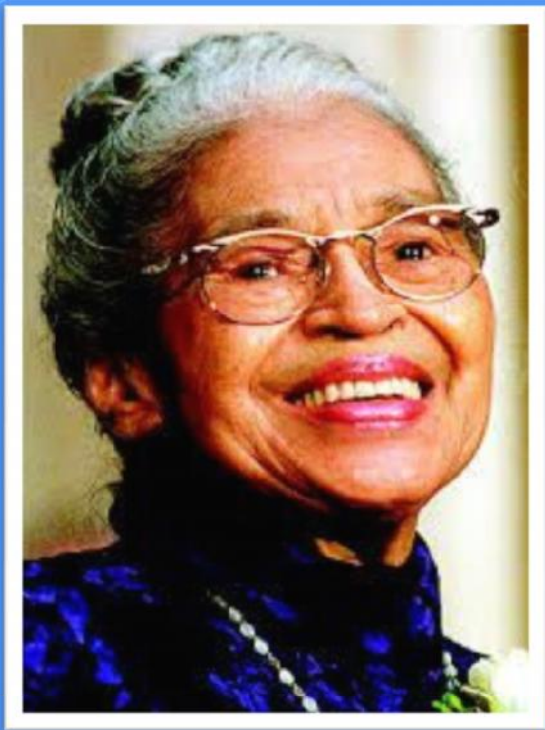
